Today students in Stage 2 and 3 were given the Archdiocesan Public Speaking Competition topics for 2019.

Year 3 – Best Friends

Year 4 – Good Advice

Year 5 – Don't try this

Year 6 – The view from the top

Stage 2 (Years 3 & 4): Speeches will go for 2 minutes with a warning bell at 1 minute 30 seconds and at 2 minutes.

Stage 3 (Years 5 & 6): Speeches will go for 3 minutes with a warning bell at 2 minutes 30 seconds and at 3 minutes.

Attached is the Archdiocesan Public Speaking Rubric. All speeches will be marked according to this rubric. Please make sure your child has read through the rubric and addressed each aspect thoroughly.

The students will be presenting their speech to their own class during Week 5, therefore they need to have their speech ready by **Monday 19th August**. Leading up to this date, they are asked to continue preparing and practising at home. However, the students will also have time to practise in class, so they need to have access to their speech at school. All students are required to present a speech as it counts toward class assessment.

There will be three students chosen from each year level in each class to present their speech to the stage. From here there will be two students chosen from each year level to compete at home against students from St Anne's Temora at the Western Region final. WR Public Speaking will be on 4th September in Cootamundra.
