Dear Parents and Caregivers,

As part of the Physical Activity and Sports Studies (PASS) unit 'Aquatic Award', students are completing sessions aimed at achieving the outcomes required by the Royal Life Saving Society for the Bronze Medallion, Bronze Star or other certificates which are dependent on the level of your child's skill and confidence. This level will be discussed between the student and their teacher.

The outcomes covered in this unit of work relate to Participating with Safety and Careers in Health & Fitness. The water safety skills are a relevant and practical component of many careers within the Fitness & Outdoor Education Industry, as well as for personal safety and survival around aquatic environments.

During Weeks 6 to 8, students will be assessed on their theoretical knowledge and practical skills. This will be conducted during the students' regular PASS lessons. All learning activities and assessments are compulsory for satisfactory completion of their school assessment in the PASS Course.

After successful completion, your child may be awarded their Bronze Medallion, Bronze Star or other Certificate of Completion. To receive the official recognition and certificate offered by the Royal Lifesaving Society, the student will incur an additional cost (see below). Payment must be received before I can send for their certificate.
