Sacred Heart Central School has a long standing tradition over 30 years old, of Year 9 students enacting the Passion of Christ for our Parish Community on Good Friday at 3pm. This liturgy is a significant and special event in the life of our School and Parish. This year, as in previous years, Sacred Heart School and schools from the Western Deanery will be invited to attend the **students' enactment on Holy Thursday 29th March at 10am (Week 9)**.

The school's presentation of the Passion Play for our Parish community occurs on **Good Friday, 30th March**, which follows Holy Thursday. It is important that students and families are aware that Easter is during the school term this year, but students will still need to confirm their availability with parents. We appreciate that some families will have made commitments that clash with these times and understand if you have made prior arrangements. However, we would appreciate if you could please let us know as soon as possible if your son or daughter will be unavailable for the Good Friday enactment as this will affect casting. Students in this situation will still have a significant part to play as there are many other jobs, outside the acting parts, that need filling. The roles for this year's presentation have been allocated. Please check with your child and confirm attendance as soon as possible. It is expected that if your child nominates for a part in this liturgy then they are required to attend all the practices as well as be available on Holy Thursday and Good Friday.


Would you please complete the permission note attached and return it to Mr O'Brien at school by Friday 2nd March. Another note will be sent home in the coming weeks indicating practice times for the play and it would be appreciated if no out of school appointments are made for students during these times.
