Dear Parents,

Extra-curricular study sessions for Years 7, 8 and 9 will recommence this term and will be running every Monday afternoon from Week 6.

The study sessions will take place in the Library and will run from 3:30pm until 5:15pm. The Secondary PCAs (Ms Erryn Marsay, Mr Timothy Mahon and Mr Andrew Alderman) will be rostered on to supervise the sessions with other teachers attending on a rotating basis. It is expected that students come prepared with work to study or assignments to complete. Any students not making correct use of this time or distracting others will be asked to leave the group.

This is a great opportunity for all Year 7, 8, 9 students to complete a solid block of work early in the school week, help develop positive study habits, and will be particularly beneficial for those who do not have computer/internet access at home. We commend the students for their continued interest in such sessions and am sure they will make effective use of this time.

There is an expectation that they will undertake periods of quiet sustained individual study and then some time may be given to teacher supported assistance or group work. There will be a exercise break during the afternoon to ensure students stretch and change scene. All phones will be left on the front desk to reduce distractions. Students must be collected from the school library and are not permitted to leave early unless they are collected and they may not walk home.
